A Note From Bryan - The Christian View of the Old Testament

The Christian view of the Old Testament is a challenge to young Christians. Many Christians are not sure what role the Old Testament plays in our faith. Even sincere believers in Jesus blur the lines between the Old and New Testaments which leads to some very unhealthy teachings promulgated as truth. In 1 Corinthians 10:11 Paul shared with young Christians that what happened to the Israelites in the Old Testament serves as an example of what can happen to the church today. People can be led away into disobedience subject to God's judgment.

Paul recounted several incidences of how the nation of Israel, God's people began well but fell into disobedience and finally received God's judgment. That same progression can befall the Lord's church if we allow temptation to cause us to fall without getting back up to finish the race of life. In verses 5-9 Paul cited several examples of disobedience in the wilderness between Egypt and Sinai.

Paul introduced 1 Corinthians 10 with the preface found in 1 Corinthians 9:24-27. Our Christian life is like a race in that there will be winners and there will be losers. The "Christian" worldview is tainted by a teaching that once a person is saved they can never fall from grace. Yet Paul's teaching is overflowing with statements that contradict such teaching. 1 Corinthians 10:12 is one such verse that refutes the idea that a Christian cannot fall from grace, 1 Corinthians 10:12 "Therefore let him who thinks he stands take heed lest he fall."

This morning we are going to look at the hurdles we have to overcome in this life that threaten to trip us up and make us fall as we seek to live for Christ in this world.
