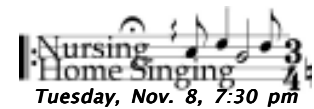

They Are Out There! Luke 19:1-10

There was a man named Zacchaeus who was a very important tax collector and very rich. He wanted to see who Jesus was, but couldn't because he was so short that he couldn't see over or around the crowd. So he ran and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see Jesus. Wouldn't it be wonderful if people would make this kind of effort and have this desire to see Jesus at worship, to hear Jesus in the daily study of His Word, and to live for Jesus by bringing others to Him! When the Lord saw Zacchaeus up in the sycamore tree, He said to him, Zacchaeus, come down, I'm going to stay at your house today! Then Zacchaeus came down quickly. He was happy to have Jesus in his house! All the people saw this. They began to complain, Look at the kind of man Jesus is! "He has gone to be a guest with a man who is a sinner!"

I'm not sure how those of us who are members at Woodstock Church of Christ today would react to the actions of Jesus with sinners if he were physically among us now. I do know, however, that many who regard themselves as sinners are still excited to know they are actually welcomed by Jesus as they repent. Zacchaeus said, "Look, Lord I give half of my goods to the poor, and if I have taken anything from anyone I will give it back four times." Jesus said, "Today, salvation has come to this house."

Those of us who have been in Christ a long time need to be re-awakened to the hunger that many people have for the Lord. Let's help them find Him by looking for those seeking a better life! Then, let's welcome them as Jesus did, always remembering how Jesus forgave our sin.

God help us to open our eyes to see those around us who are seeking after Jesus. Give us the wisdom to know when to speak, what to say, and the courage to act so that we can be instrumental in saving a soul as they are searching to come to know Jesus.
