Members of the scrapbooking team for Lads to Leaders are encouraged to attend. See Katrina Rivero or Jenny Aguirre for details on this event.

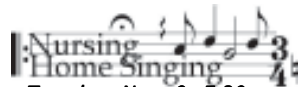
## EEM \$1,000,000 Sunday Today

### A Note From Bryan. . . Wisdom

Proverbs 1:20 reads, "Wisdom calls aloud outside; she raises her voice in the open squares." Did you notice the feminine personification of wisdom? This is consistent with at least four other contexts in the book of Proverbs. I have never studied the Hebrew language so I can't say anything about the Hebrew word translated in Proverbs as "wisdom." However, having studied Greek, the original language of the New Testament, the word for "wisdom" is *sophia* which we know has been a popular woman's name for centuries. I just thought that was an interesting tidbit to share with you as we look at the subject of wisdom from James 3:13-18.

The world has its ideas about how wisdom is to be defined and God has left us His word to reveal to us His ideal of how wisdom should be defined. In our text for this morning James reveals the differences between the world's ideas and God's ideas about wisdom. We all want to be wise to a degree but I wonder sometimes if we seek wisdom from above with the same ambition, drive, and determination that we pursue other things in this world.

One of the local Atlanta media affiliates interviewed one of Gwinnett County's new commissioners for the six o'clock news one evening last week. This particular newly appointed commissioner wanted to reassure the citizens of the county that any decisions would be made with the best wisdom, understanding, and knowledge "available at that time." While I understood the intent of the message I have heard similar statements made so often that it has become practically meaningless. My point is that it's anyone's idea what "wisdom" refers to at any given moment and how could I possibly be reassured by such a vague statement?

God didn't leave it up to us to figure out what "wisdom" is or what it means. God revealed character and characteristics that make it easy for us to swim in this sea of confusion with confidence that we can know what God wants and intends when it comes to you and I developing wisdom in our lives.
