A Note From Bryan... A Cry for Help

Did you know that listening intently could possibly be the one thing that diffuses a tense situation? Often times, being heard is the one single thing that stands between the escalation and resolution to a problem. Every single person wants to be heard. Whether it is ideas or concerns people want to be assured that their story has been heard. When a person is allowed to completely share their perspective, often it transforms the conflict by neutralizing strong emotions.

Even more importantly, Christians want to know that God hears their prayers. While it is important to have the empathy of others, it is crucial to know that God is there and that He cares about what is happening to us. We want to know that God hears us when we are concerned, afraid, and anxious. The Psalmist wrote, "Hear Me when I call, O God of My righteousness! You have relieved my distress; Have mercy on me, and hear my prayer."

God's word gives us the assurance that God does indeed hear us when we cry out for His help. God told Solomon that He would hear and respond, 2 Chronicles 7:12-15. Acts 10 tells the story of a devout man who feared God, gave alms, and prayed always and was saved because God heard his earnest calls for help. In today's lesson, I will point out several occasions recorded in Matthew chapters 20-22 when people cried out for salvation, and how Jesus was able to make a considerable difference in the lives of those who recognized His ability to help them and save them when they called out.
