A Note From Bryan... More Like Jesus

Have you noticed that cell phone makers have been trying to make newer smart phones that look and operate like the iPhone? Every major carrier is now introducing phones with touch screen interfaces in order to compete with the venerable iPhone. MP3 players all did the same thing with the advent of the iPod; they tried to come up with similar features and storage capacities. It is said that imitation is the sincerest form of flattery. In the digital world it seems like everyone wants to be like Apple. Their products just seem to have a wow-factor and cool-factor that others can't imitate.

When a person obeys the gospel their ambition is to be more like Jesus. He's the author of "I-will give you rest," and "I-will not leave you nor forsake you." How cool is that? There is no one on earth that can guarantee these sorts of things either. Forget touch screens, scroll wheels, and endless "cool" applications Jesus is the original that inspires the kind of imitation that others respect and want for themselves. Jesus calls us to imitate Him. The gospels record many times when all Jesus had to say was, "Follow Me" and people dropped what they were doing and followed.

There have been an endless number of lessons on imitating Christ so I'm not sharing anything new with you today, but we are going to look at being more like Jesus in the way we practice spiritual disciplines, the way we show compassion, and in our commitment/dedication to Jesus and His church. There are many ways in which we can be more like Jesus. Our job is to notice those things, through our study and reflection upon His life and ministry, and apply those characteristics to our own lives.

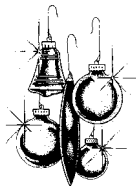
