A Note From Bryan. . . Where will you be?

Do you remember when the space shuttle *Challenger* exploded shortly after takeoff? Do you remember where you were and what you felt? Growing up I always heard older adults talk about the Kennedy assassination in this way; they all remembered where they were and what a significant impact it had on their lives at the time. I remember the attempt on Ronald Reagan's life in 1980. John Hinkley, Jr. is a name I won't soon forget or the obsession he held for actress Jody Foster. I will always remember James Brady lying conscious on the sidewalk despite his massive injuries.

Hardly a day goes by without some mention of the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001. I remember pausing to drink in the beauty of the day as if I'd never seen a sky so clear only minutes before hearing of the first plane strike on the World Trade Center. I couldn't believe my eyes when I saw flames coming from the Pentagon. There are many days that burn in our memories. There are details significant and seemingly insignificant that surface when we recall the momentous occasions.

While there are other days to come, there is one day, more than any, that we should look forward to, and that is the day that Christ comes again. The New Testament has much to say about the characteristics of that day. Today, we will look at much of what the New Testament reveals to us about that much anticipated day. The days discussed above came unexpectedly, and, likewise, the Bible says that the Second Coming will come as a thief in the night. The difference is that God informs us so that we will prepare and anticipate the coming of the Lord. It is a fitting question to ask, where you will be when Christ comes again. Although you may not know in a physical sense, the Bible teaches you to spiritually prepare yourself for that day.
