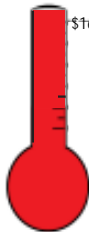

My family would like to wish all of your family a Merry Christmas. We also express our appreciation to the church for the financial support that you have given to us. It has truly been a blessing. I appreciate the opportunity to work with you at Woodstock in the proclamation of the gospel. I searched our blogspot a few days ago and discovered that we have page views from Russia and France. The church at Pisgah continues to be amazed that a small group of people are known in other parts of the world. Indeed, our mission at Pisgah is to have a "faith that is spoken of throughout the world." The church at Woodstock helps to make that possible for us. We are truly "workers together with God." I continually pray for you as I know that you do for us.
